Tasting notes

This wine has intense wild strawberry and a touch of raspberry seed on the nose with a very subtle underlying tone of ripe blackberries and spice. The palate is full of bright plum and raspberry notes that tantalise the tastebuds and linger on a lengthy, mouthwatering finish. Refined tannins give a wonderfully elegant structure; they are superbly integrated for such a young wine. Drink from 2015.

About the producer

In 1995 Jean-Marie Fourrier took over the winemaking from his father Jean-Claude, who had been making the wines since 1967, at first in partnership with his uncle, from whom many of the vines were inherited. Jean-Marie has a broader perspective than many of his fellow winemakers, as he spent time making Pinot Noir in Oregon, as well as training in France. Today, Domaine Fourrier is achieving critical acclaim but Jean-Marie is still young and ambitious to achieve even more. His star may be firmly in the ascendant but his feet are firmly rooted in the vineyards of Gevrey.
