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Tasting notes

There can be a brashness to Bâtard, sometimes seeking to impose itself by shouting over everyone else. However in 2013, we have a wine of more balanced maturity. The wine begins with discretion, slowly building, taking its time to point towards its key attributes. There is intensity here with control, the wine giving volume across the palate but never surging or lurching. Fresh and stylish, there is inner calm here, a wine comfortable in its own skin, knowing its place in the world. Drink from 2019.

About the producer

The vision of Anne-Claude Leflaive in the 1990s took this Puligny Montrachet Domaine to the heights of white wine production, not only in Burgundy but in the rest of the world. Today, her nephew Brice de La Morandière - who has had a successful career running multinational companies - continues her philosophy of organic, biodynamic viticulture, bringing Chardonnay grapes to their best possible expression in Grand Cru and Premier Cru climates, where the terroir has been restored to health by natural practices.
