Tasting notes

Fenocchio's smallest production wine, a Bussia Riserva that spends 90 days macerating on the skins. Long maceration is key to Claudio's winemaking style, and it reaches its peak here with immensely complex aromas of truffles, black cherry, rosewater, and aromatic herbs. A subtle, velvety wine with remarkable depth.

About the producer

When Claudio Fenocchio succeeded his father Giacomo at the helm of the family business in 1989, the debate between modernist and traditionalists in Barolo was at its most acute. He decided to opt for a third approach, something we can call radical traditionalism. His wines were celebrated for being impressively approachable in youth while getting even better with age. Claudio represents the 5th generation of the Fenocchio family crafting elegant, true Barolos that capture the soul of his vineyards. Far from resting on his laurels though, he continues to push boundaries of quality and innovation while respecting his family legacy.
