Tasting notes

Produced from equal parts of old Pinot Noir and Gamay vines, there is an impressive level of fruit on the nose with a lovely touch of sweet spice and savouriness. The palate displays a good mix of red and dark berries supported by a good structure of fine tannins and refreshing acidity resulting in a surprisingly complex experience and a long finish.

About the producer

One of the legendary estates in Volnay, Domaine Lafarge has been crafting understated and pure expressions of Pinot Noir for decades. Committed vignerons Michel Lafarge and his son Frederic tend to 11.6 ha of vines in Volnay and Beaune. The range is a dazzling collection of terroir-driven Burgundy's which are incredibly traditional in style. Little new oak is used in the winery allowing the purity of the fruit to shine through, giving wines of exceptional purity, focus and energy.
