Tasting notes

Crisp red apples, freshly squeezed lemon juice and greengages. The wonderful riper red apple flavours initially come through on the palate, followed by incredible amounts of chalky minerality and lime peel. The acidity is dominant but this is to be expected from such a youthful wine it shows a great structural backbone. There is a lovely creamy texture on the palate that really adds a different dimension. This is a complex wine with a huge amount of depth, I can only scratch the surface of what is to come; it is sublime even in its youth. You're in for a treat if you manage to secure a case

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sébastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closely with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
