### Tasting notes

Very, very fresh, the nose is very enticing, plenty of stone fruits. The characteristics here are softer and richer than previous wines tasted, white peach, and melon dominate on the fruit front and are very concentrated with a wonderfully creamy texture throughout the palate. The substantial minerality takes over and dominates the finish. This is a very sophisticated Chablis with great weight, structure and minerality; it's perfectly balanced.

### About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sebastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closely with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
