The nose reveals intense red fruit, cherries and strawberries with earthy, mineral notes. Delicate, complex and concentrated, this wine has a soft, full palate, well-balanced acidity and supple tannins. Ideal companion for risotto.

This Pinot combines richly elegant dark berry fruit with the wonderfully savoury, earthy depths and fine, vibrant acidity that are the hallmarks of Pinot.
