Agathe Bursin's Gewurztraminer Dirstelberg has an enveloping bouquet of wild flowers mingled with exotic notes of rose petals and lychee. The palate is perfectly balanced with silky fruit characters, a lively freshness and warming notes of spice on the finish.

Agathe Bursin, Alsace's up and coming vineyard, has been producing wines since 2000 and she is reaching ever greater heights of purity and quality. Agathe's style has always been one of richness and character with a distinct textured style; she strives to articulate the quality of her vineyards and the pure character of her noble varieties.
