Brisk, bright in colour, there are some lemon notes and a touch of fresh reduction. It is middleweight and softly oaked, with a good, crisp finish and an attractive weight of fruit. Will round out into a classic Meursault.

One of the truly great, historic domaines of Burgundy, with stunning cellars and many glorious holdings from Gevrey to Pommard, via some brilliant Grands Crus, Erwan and his new team have everything that a Burgundian could desire. Traditionally, the Faiveley style was uncompromising but while still unquestionably making some of the longest-lived wines in the Côte, there is today far more finesse and precision in evidence, pointing to a more careful and up-to-date approach.
