Tasting notes

A wine with lovely depth of refreshing fruit with hints of pear and spicy stone fruit on the nose. Apples and fig flavours are balanced by a tight mineral structure which leads to a long and silky finish.

About the producer

Agathe Bursin, Alsace's up and coming vineyard, has been producing wines since 2000 and she is reaching ever greater heights of purity and quality. Agathe's style has always been one of richness and character with a distinct textured style; she strives to articulate the quality of her vineyards and the pure character of her noble varieties. Her reputation is very much on the increase as she gains greater recognition outside of France. Despite this rising profile, she maintains exceptionally sensible pricing. Lovers of classic, textural Alsatian wines have a lot to investigate here.
