### Tasting notes

Rich and powerful with lovely weight of elegant fruit, this is magnificently complex and satisfying wine. A bouquet of tropical honeyed fruits with hints of wild flowers and truffles is followed by a rich palate balanced by an energetic acidity which leads to a long and mineral finish.

Agathe Bursin, Alsace's up and coming vineyard, has been producing wines since 2000 and she is reaching ever greater heights of purity and quality. Agathe's style has always been one of richness and character with a distinct textured style; she strives to articulate the quality of her vineyards and the pure character of her noble varieties.
