### Tasting notes

Falanghina is one of the unsung Italian white varieties that is fast gaining in popularity and rightly so. This is a vibrant wine with plenty of richness and elegant citrusy fruit. There are notes of apple and quince, alongside some nutty complexity, soft spice and a lean mineral streak. The attractive notes of orchard fruits lead through on to the palate which is layered with conference pear and white blossom. Long and fragrant on the finish, this is a great wine that is delicious with summer salads, poultry and fish. A real all-rounder!

### About the producer

La Guardiense is a co-operative at Guardia Sanframondi near Benevento in Campania. There are now some 1,000 members, owning vineyards on excellent plots in the 40km long valley and slopes around La Guardia. In 2006, they revolutionised their winemaking and cellarage with the arrival of celebrated oenologist Riccardo Cottarella and now bottle their very best wines, of which the Falanghina and Greco are the two that we have selected for our portfolio.
