Tasting notes

Hauntingly youthful. This Clos du Bourg gently reveals delicate aromas of orange blossom, red apples and mandarin. There is depth, breadth and complexity here with an almost tannic apple skin-like texture which provides a superb backbone alongside that unmistakable vein of acidity that runs throughout. Precise and impeccably balanced, this is a highly elegant and refined expression of Vouvray and, more precisely, this outstanding vineyard.

About the producer

Few producers can claim a level of influence to almost identify with their appellation – one of those is Domaine Huet. This iconic estate has been one of the standard-bearers of Vouvray since 1928. A true pioneer, Gaston Huet was one of the first vigneron to adopt biodynamic practices and to focus on single-vineyard bottlings. Remaining true to the philosophy of the founders, Sarah Hwang and Jean-Bertrand Berthomé continue to craft superbly long-lived Chenin Blanc from their three vineyards. From lively sparkling to unctuous Moelleux, the Domaine Huet range is the most extraordinary way to venture into Vouvray.
