Tasting notes

Gaja's Sorì San Lorenzo is made from old vines on steep, south facing slopes with poor soils composed of clayey-calcerous marls. It is the most powerful of the single vineyard Barbarescos with the capacity to age for 40 years or more. The 2014 follows very much in this style with intense deep cherry and dark berry aromas with notes of blueberry, wild herbs and Mediterranean spices. The palate is intensely rich and refreshing with compact dark fruits and seamless tannins. An elegant mineral character and hints of black chocolate with a spicy, cedar note on the finish give superb depth and great definition. This is a very impressive and multi-layered wine which will need some time in bottle before drinking.
