Tasting notes

The Côte de Léchet vineyard has a mix of classic Chablis Kimmeridge and chalk soils resulting in a wine of lovely concentration. Shows on the nose with notes of green apples and pears. On the palate the wine meets you with a really fresh acidity and a saline minerality balanced by crisp green apples, conference pears and the freshness of citrus fruits.

About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sebastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closing with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
