### Tasting notes

The Les Lys vineyard is North facing, resulting in a cool climate Chablis with good minerality. Sébastien's vines are 60 years old on average in this vineyard resulting in a concentrated Chablis, with a lovely aromatic nose showing small hints of toffee with good saline minerality and a classic fresh acidity.

### About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sébastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closely with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
