Tasting notes

The Chablis village is a blend of 5 different parcels ranging from 10-45 year old vines. The wine shows a lovely fresh nose with crisp green apples matched by acidity with grapefruit notes. All in all the wine is very pure and lean with crisp citrus notes.

About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sébastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closely with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
