A subtle and beautiful bouquet of soft pomegranate and red plum aromas. The palate reveals notes of fresh raspberries and cranberries balanced by delicate tannins and a captivating vitality in its structure and acidity all the way to the finish. Drink from 2016.

About the producer

In 1995 Jean-Marie Fourrier took over the winemaking from his father Jean-Claude, who had been making the wines since 1967, at first in partnership with his uncle, from whom many of the vines were inherited. Jean-Marie has a broader perspective than many of his fellow winemakers, as he spent time making Pinot Noir in Oregon, as well as training in France. Even an hour in his company is an eye-opening experience: if there is a more thoughtful and inquisitive winemaker in Burgundy today, we are yet to meet him. Today, Domaine Fourrier is achieving critical acclaim but Jean-Marie is still young and ambitious to achieve even more. His star may be firmly in the ascendant but his feet are firmly rooted in the vineyards of Gevrey. We are convinced that his will be one of the most revered names in the region for both current and future generations.
