Tasting notes

A Bouquet showing the cherry and violet note characteristic of the varietals; subtle wood tones complement its full and round fruit flavors. Compact tannins and pleasant acidity carry this traditional South Tyrolean wine through to its long finish.

About the producer

One of the oldest estates in Trentino Alto Adige, Tiefenbrunner Schlosskellerei Turmhof has a history of high-quality winemaking dating back to the mid-19th century. Before the end of the 2nd World War, Herbert Tiefenbrunner started work as a winemaker when he was only 15 years of age. Along with his wife, they took over the winery in 2000 with a commitment to continue in the centuries-old tradition of Tiefenbrunner wine-making culture. His philosophy is crafting wines with a distinctive personality, to outlast fashion and trends. The result is a vibrant, expressive range that concentrates on single varietal, mountain fruit.
