This is a rich mouthful, balanced with refreshing acidity and warm citrus fruits.

About the producer

The world-famous Chardonnay is at home here since it takes its name from an ancient village in the Mâconnais region. Between the plain of the Saône and the Beaujolais heights, the siliceous granite soils here allow the vines to flourish beautifully.

The grapes used are sourced from the villages of Prissé, Sologny and Verzé which are located in the southern part of Mâconnais, close to Saint Veran and the Pouilly fuissé area.

The harvest is brought in to a schedule based on the progress of ripening in the plots. The juice is extracted slowly at low pressure by pneumatic pressing. Filtering at the end of the process ensures the wine is as clear and bright as possible.
