Tasting notes

Lemon, apricot and pear are all enlivened by white flowers and a touch of spice on the refined nose of this excellent Pinot Gris. The vines at Dirstelberg are 42 years old and the site is characterised by pink sandstone that delivers an ample character to the wines. Bright and rich in the mouth, with suave flavours of ripe peach and sweet spice, it is very juicy and fresh on the long, smooth and classically dry finish.

About the producer

Agathe Bursin, Alsace's up and coming vineyard, has been producing wines since 2000 and she is reaching ever greater heights of purity and quality. Agathe's style has always been one of richness and character with a distinct textured style; she strives to articulate the quality of her vineyards and the pure character of her noble varieties. Her reputation is very much on the increase as she gains greater recognition outside of France. Despite this rising profile, she maintains exceptionally sensible pricing. Lovers of classic, textural Alsatian wines have a lot to investigate here.
