Tasting notes

Attractive and refreshing, this is a relatively full flavoured rosé with bright aromas of wild strawberries and raspberries. Succulent and ripe on the palate with an appealing freshness to balance and subtle notes of wild herbs and spices, this wine would be wonderful on a hot summer's day. Enjoy with lemon and wild garlic seabass.

About the producer

Puech Noble was originally named Puech Chaud and it is located in a relatively cool microclimate, in the Côteaux du Languedoc near Nîmes. The wines feature a slight garrique character and this is the only hint that the wines do not originate from the Northern Rhône. Bought in the late 1990s by René Rostaing and his wife, the estate gave René a chance to produce Syrah on the limestone soils so beloved by many French growers. Puech Noble is now producing one of the South's most beautiful wines, mainly from Syrah, but also including small quantities of Mourvèdre, Grenache, and Rolle. Indeed, it could even be the best expression of Rostaing wines to date. They are beautifully expressive, rich, elegant, ethereal and hedonistic, yet modest and subtle.
