Tasting notes

Tua Rita's Rosso dei Notri can best be described as the second wine of all the wines from the estate. Made up of 50% Sangiovese and the remainder a combination of Syrah, Redigaffi's Merlot, Cabernet from Giusto di Notri, and Sangiovese from Perlato del Bosco; it is a dramatic synthesis of the property's vineyards. Full and plush, notes of dark cherry and plum combine with sweet spice to create an extremely attractive aroma. The palate is juicy and concentrated with a fantastic streak of freshness, lifting the wine right through to a very long finish. Rosso dei Notri 2014 is such incredible value for money, it exceeds expectations yet again.

About the producer

Founded in 1984, Tua Rita was instrumental in establishing the 'cult' status of the earliest Super Tuscans. Nestled in the 'metalliferous hills' of the Maremma in the coastal region of Tuscany, the original plot of 2 hectares has now grown to 30 and Tua Rita have carved out a reputation for being some of the best producers of Cabernet and Merlot in Tuscany. Today, second generation winemaker Stefano Frascaola continues to push the boundaries of Italian wine, experimenting with new varieties and techniques, and recent releases of these wines are the best they have ever been.
