Tasting notes

61% Merlot/39% Cabernet Franc The spiciness of Cabernet Franc combines with the generous, plump aromas of Merlot. We remain in fresh red fruit territory with sufficient tension and precise detail and- perhaps the vintage hallmark- those terrific, juicy tannins again, along with an extra dash of cream. As you work the wine on the palate, it really starts to move through the gears, leaving the richness of the attack behind, with the finish showing admirable persistence and trailing floral aromatics. This is really very good: a year or three in bottle will certainly be beneficial. Drink 2019-2025+

The Bordeaux En Primeur campaign can be overwhelming deciding which Châteaux to get involved with and where to get the most for your money, so let us steer your attention to Château Lafleur and a wine where both quality and value intersect - G Acte.

Tim Atkin MW describes the owners of Lafleur, the Guinaudeau family, as the "*Burgundian of Bordelais, both in the vineyard and the cellar,*" describing their wines as "*all about finesse, balance and gentle, unhurried complexity.
