### Tasting notes

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The 2015 Camp Chardonnay comes from organically and sustainably farmed vineyards in the Alexander and Sonoma Valleys. Fermented in stainless steel and then transferred to neutral French oak for 10 weeks, this wine displays a delicious freshness and mineral composure. Notes of lime, lemon and gentle white florals combine with zesty acidity to create a moreish, immediately appealing wine. A great aperitif or accompaniment to light fish dishes or salads. Camp Chardonnay represents seriously good value for money from this innovative young winemaker.

### About the producer

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One of the most original thinkers in Californian winemaking, Kenny Likitprakong started The Hobo Wine Company as a deliberately itinerant winemaker concentrating on acquiring very specific parcels of grapes, timing harvests perfectly and vinifying naturally. While he has now settled in a permanent bunkhouse for the fermentation in Santa Rosa, he keeps a fluid approach to his wines. This incredibly thrilling range is an invitation to explore the various, maybe lesser-known, terroir of Sonoma and is a testament to Kenny's deep understanding of terroir and his precise winemaking.
