Vibrant yellow with reflects of pale green. Intensely fresh with fruits and flowers. Fresh, mineral, harmonious and fruity. The finish is long and precise. Freshness and promptness make the elegance of this wine of pleasure to the green apple accents on a very pretty mineral structure.

About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the southeast of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sebastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closing with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
