### Tasting notes

Rosewater, lychee and exotic, tropical flavours emerge from the glass in wonderful harmony here. What an attractive nose. There is poise, balance and ripe orange, tangerine and tropical fruit all in evidence on the palate. Extremely gratifying, this is voluptuous and creamy Gewürztraminer which shows a refreshing finish of real depth and a lovely cleansing and balancing acidity.

Agathe Bursin, Alsace's up and coming vineyard, has been producing wines since 2000 and she is reaching ever greater heights of purity and quality. Agathe's style has always been one of richness and character with a distinct textured style; she strives to articulate the quality of her vineyards and the pure character of her noble varieties.
