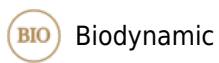

"Dark ruby garnet, violet reflections, delicate bright ocher. Ripe black cherries, cassis and liquorice, fine floral nuances, tobacco-like appeal, a hint of cedar, multi-faceted Syrah bouquet. Juicy, extremely elegant, subtle extract sweetness, convincing aromatic depth, perfectly ripe tannins, silky like a Margaux, sweet currants in the finish, salty and mineral, lingers for minutes, has already reached the first drinking point and has aging potential. About the producer

Château Maris is one of the most forward-looking producers in the world, named a "sustainability hero" by Jancis Robinson MW and awarded a 'Green Emblem' by the Wine Advocate. It was the first European vineyard to receive the B Corporation certification, an incredibly rigorous sustainability award that is only held by 34 wineries worldwide today. Maris boasts a world-first carbon-negative winery constructed from hemp bricks, while the vineyards are hand-harvested and tilled by a horse-drawn plough. Sales of their wine support local wildlife and biodiversity initiatives such as L'Aspas and La Masion de L'Abeille, and they have even made headlines for shipping wine to the USA by sailboat!
