### Tasting notes

Produced from organic grapes, this is bright, crisp and wonderfully floral. The enticing perfume is dominated by apricot and baked apple notes, but a lovely floral aromatic is certainly present. Bright, dense and juicy on the palate, there is a wonderful purity to the white stone fruit and ripe tropical flavours. Lutzeltal is a very gravelly site, with vines around 85 years old. It is known to create extremely refined Sylvaners and the depth and complexity on offer here suggest this is another fine example.

### About the producer

Agathe Bursin, Alsace's up and coming vineyard, has been producing wines since 2000 and she is reaching ever greater heights of purity and quality. Agathe's style has always been one of richness and character with a distinct textured style; she strives to articulate the quality of her vineyards and the pure character of her noble varieties. Her reputation is very much on the increase as she gains greater recognition outside of France. Despite this rising profile, she maintains exceptionally sensible pricing. Lovers of classic, textural Alsatian wines have a lot to investigate here.
