A vineyard with a southerly exposure allows the grapes to ripen well. An elegant nose, with hints of white flowers leads to a palate with chalky mineral textures and an intense citrus flavour with notes of grapefruit and lemon. Drink from 2017.

About the producer

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the south-east of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sebastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closing with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis – mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
