Tasting notes

Produced from a south facing parcel at the extreme south of Les Vaillons, this unique wine is vinified in a concrete egg to give an additional layer of complexity. The shape of the egg creates a circulating effect for the lees while the porosity of the surface allows for micro-oxidation like a barrique but without any woody characters. The beautifully textured and intensely refreshing wine will be delicious in a year or two. Drink from 2017.

Nestled between the 1er Cru vineyards of Côte de Léchet and Vaillons in the southeast of Chablis, Domaine Sébastien Dampt stretches over 7 ha of some of the most sought-after terroirs in the region. Sebastien set up his Domaine in 2007, after working closing with his father Daniel and brother Vincent at Domaine Daniel Dampt. A clear superstar of the future, his wines are some of the purest, most ethereal expressions of Chablis - mostly vinified in stainless steel to safeguard the fruit's nuanced expression of his terroirs.
