Tasting notes

Les Clos enjoys a southerly aspect with very white deep clay soils resting on a limestone bed which brings great complexity to the wine. Remarkably elegant, the bouquet reveals floral spice notes with a breezy mineral quality. The palate is broadly textured and generous with green apple and pithy citrus fruits balanced by a refreshing lemon character. A wine with impressive depth, it would benefit from five or more years in bottle before drinking. Drink from 2022.

Joseph Henriot purchased this fabulous but underperforming domaine in 1998 and the results have been nothing short of dramatic. In a mere ten years, Fèvre has gone to the top of the premier league, re-establishing a style that with its minerality, purity and lip-smacking acidity is right in line with what great Chablis should be all about. The problem on the horizon though is supply as everybody wants these wines all around the world and the days of top Chablis selling at a huge discount to the Côte d'Or may be numbered. With Didier Segulier at the helm, the future at Fèvre appears very bright and with the 2009s just released, we have another set of beautiful wines to thrill loyal fans and recent converts alike.
