### Tasting notes

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Concentrated and elegant with a firm mineral backbone, this persistent wine has a nose of pithy citrus fruits with hints of white peach, grapefruit and flower blossom. The palate is concentrated and tightly coiled with chalky mineral characters and just a hint of spice. A wine for the long term, it will develop richness and complexity over the next ten years or so. Drink from 2022.

### About the producer

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Founded in 1731 in Beaune by Michel Bouchard, Bouchard Père & Fils, is one of the oldest wine estates in Burgundy, perpetuating tradition for nearly 3 centuries and 9 generations. This desire to build up an exceptional estate in Côte d'Or endured through the generations and acquisitions in the best Villages were added throughout the 19th century and again in the early 20th century. Today the estate boasts 130 hectares of vines, of which 12 are classed Grand Cru and 74 classed as Premier Cru. Combining tradition and innovation, Bouchard Père & Fils works hard to bring out the distinctiveness of each successive vineyard and vintage, striving to make its wines exquisite works of art, each with its own personality and charm.
