Tasting notes

The fourth vintage of the Folk Machine's red wine blend continues to fit into their ideas and hopes of what a California bistro wine can and should be. Light on it's feet, great with food, fun and easy to drink, and affordable.

Parts & Labor is a selection of older California vineyards and varieties from sometimes obscure and off the beaten path areas. This time it is a blend of 44% Syrah from the Biodynamically farmed Vecino Vineyard in Potter Valley, 30% Carignane from 100 year old Organically farmed vines planted in Redwood Valley, 12% Grenache from Cedar Lane in Arroyo Seco, 10% Barbera from Fox Hill in mendocino.

About the producer

One of the most original thinkers in Californian winemaking, Kenny Likitprakong started The Hobo Wine Company as a deliberately itinerant winemaker concentrating on acquiring very specific parcels of grapes, timing harvests perfectly and vinifying naturally. While he has now settled in a permanent bunkhouse for the fermentation in Santa Rosa, he keeps a fluid approach to his wines. This incredibly thrilling range is an invitation to explore the various, maybe lesser-known, terroir of Sonoma and is a testament to Kenny's deep understanding of terroir and his precise winemaking.
