### About the producer

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With a domaine that was established at the end of the 18th century, Etienne Grivot has often felt the weight of history. Joining his father Jean in 1982, Etienne's first ten years at the Domaine were a time of experimentation and by his own admission, the results were not always to his standards. Whilst the health of the vineyards had improved dramatically, the winemaking remained a work in progress. 1993 marked a turning point, however, since then the trajectory of Domaine Grivot has been nothing but upwards. Today, a more mellowed and confident Etienne is one of the most respected figures in the region, producing wines of purity, freshness and precision year-in, year-out. We asked Etienne what his secret was and he offered us this priceless pearl of wisdom: 'You must have the courage to do nothing'. The future looks bright for this fabulous Domaine.
