The 2017 Corton-Rognet Grand Cru has a refined, perfumed bouquet, with scents of peony emerging with time. This is very pretty and winsome. The fresh palate is well balanced with fine tannin, perfectly judged acidity and a sophisticated finish that does this appellation proud. There is a wonderful, persistent saline aftertaste.
