### Tasting notes

Deep ruby red colour.

The nose is fresh, intense and very fruity. The palate is velvety and round, the tannins are soft and structured. The mouth is very long, complex and harmonious.

### About the producer

Based in Gevrey Chambertin and founded in 1976 by Alain, the estate is now run by brothers Jean Luc and Eric. With 9.5ha of vineyard, the brothers have a strong focus on sustainable viticulture with biodynamic practices. The wines are 100% destemmed with a limited amount of new oak, unfined, unfiltered with minimum intervention in term of pidgeage and racking. The brothers strive to continue their father's legacy of wines that are clean and natural with very little sulphur dioxide, expressive of their terroirs, and most of all elegant.
