Tasting notes

The 2017 Pommard Clos des Arvelets 1er comes from a parcel that originally belonged to the Rebougeon family's great-grandmother. It has a slightly muted bouquet at first, demanding encouragement from the glass and eventually revealing blackberry and briar aromas. The palate is medium-bodied with soy-tinged black fruit and a little grainy in texture, but there is fine grip on the spicy finish. Good potential.
