Tasting notes

100% Viognier, this wine matures half in barrique and half in amphorae after three days' maceration. Certainly one of the more unusual wines in our portfolio! The rich, aromatic style of this wine is undeniably true to Viognier's stone-fruit profile, but with added layers of Greek yoghurt, pineapple, and salted caramel.

About the producer

Michele Satta is one of the founders of Bolgheri DOC over twenty years ago, alongside Tenuta San Guido, Ornellaia, and the Antinori family. However, despite their importance to the meteoric rise of the region, they have remained a boutique, terroir-driven producer that continues to push the boundaries of Italian fine wine. Unlike better-known names, Satta focuses on Mediterranean varieties – particularly Sangiovese and Syrah – alongside Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Today, Michele's son Giacomo heads the Estate, producing wine with a "fierce spirit of independence" according to Monica Larner of the Wine Advocate.
