### Tasting notes

Combining lovely fruitiness with an attractive freshness and characteristic minerality, Chablis is a wine region with global renown. Domaine William Fèvre's vineyards sit on Kimmeridgian subsoil and enjoy ideal exposures for the production of a very fine wine.

The 2020 Chablis has a fleshy and elegant bouquet revealing citrus, white fruits and flowers aromas. The mouth is fresh, supple underscored by mineral. Pair it with fish dishes, grilled or in a light sauce; various seafood, oysters and sushis.

### About the producer

William Fèvre is one of Chablis's most respected domaines and is credited with putting this region of Chardonnay vines, William began purchasing parcels of the region's Premier and Grand Cru vineyards that had fallen out of fashion. He quickly grew the estate to an impressive 50 hectares and established a fine reputation for his white Burgundy. He retired in 1998 and sold the estate to négociant Bouchard, who installed Didier Séguier as winemaker.
