The color is a ruby red with lively violet reflections. The scent is fresh and pleasantly fruity. The taste is dry and pleasantly bitter with a good and balanced body. The particular characteristics of Dolcetto make it an excellent everyday wine, pairing well with all types of food, from appetizers to cheeses and good in any season.

## About the producer

When Claudio Fenocchio succeeded his father Giacomo at the helm of the family business in 1989, the debate between modernist and traditionalists in Barolo was at its most acute. He decided to opt for a third approach, something we can call radical traditionalism. His wines were celebrated for being impressively approachable in youth while getting even better with age. Claudio represents the 5th generation of the Fenocchio family crafting elegant, true Barolos that capture the soul of his vineyards. Far from resting on his laurels though, he continues to push boundaries of quality and innovation while respecting his family legacy.
