Rich and exuberant with tropical hints and spice. Fresh acidity and earthy minerality provide backbone and this has good length. A wonderfully composed Pinot Gris with everything in exactly the right place. Succulent and charming, this will drink really well as soon as it lands.

A true Alsatian gem, the Domaine stretches over 23ha of vineyards now farmed according to organic viticulture. From the only vineyard in the world to produce Sylvaner with Grand Cru status, to their concentrated and powerful Rieslings to bewitching Gewürztraminer, there is plenty for any wine aficionado to love.
